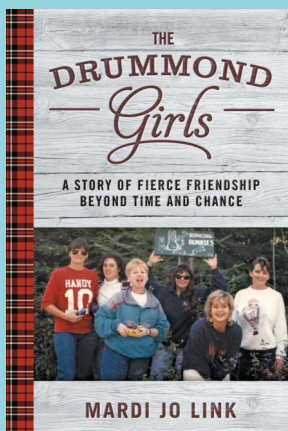


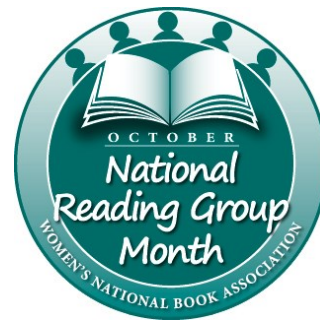
SUSAN CRANDALL
